



Terms & Conditions Deep Dive Truffle Ceremony

1. Booking & Payment

Your place is confirmed once full payment has been received.

2. Cancellation Policy

If you cancel your participation:

- More than 30 days before the event: 90% refund
- Between 14 and 30 days before the event: 65% refund
- Within 14 days of the event: no refund

If you are unable to attend, please contact us as soon as possible. Depending on availability, we may offer the possibility to transfer your booking to another ceremony, although this cannot be guaranteed.

3. Changes or Cancellation by the Organisers

We reserve the right to make reasonable changes to the schedule, venue, facilitators, or programme if necessary.

Should we need to cancel the event, you will receive a 95% refund of your payment (5% covers non-refundable administrative and payment processing costs). We cannot accept responsibility for any additional expenses such as travel or accommodation.

4. Health & Participation

Participation is subject to completing our screening questionnaire honestly and in full.

We reserve the right to decline or postpone participation if we believe attending the ceremony may not be safe for you or for the group.

Providing inaccurate or incomplete medical or psychological information may result in exclusion from the ceremony without refund.



5. Medical Responsibility

Our ceremonies are intended for personal growth and self-exploration. They are not a substitute for medical, psychiatric, or psychological treatment.

Participants remain responsible for consulting their own physician regarding any medical conditions or prescribed medications. We do not advise participants to discontinue prescribed medication.

6. Participant Responsibility

By attending the ceremony, you acknowledge that participation is voluntary and that you take personal responsibility for your own physical, emotional, and psychological wellbeing before, during, and after the event.
